<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	This course will equip language teachers and trainers with the essential skills and knowledge to effectively use ICT (Information & Communications Technology) in their own teaching or training contexts. It will provide them with the opportunity to try out new websites, examine new apps and develop a social media presence while considering the important aspect of online safety policy and procedures. They will then reflect on how this can be applied to their specific context and develop their own personal ICT development plan.
<b>OBJECTIVES</b>	<p>This course will provide teachers with the opportunity to develop their ICT skills and examine ways in which these can be incorporated into the language learning classroom. The course is suitable for those teachers who have IT experience as well as those who are relatively inexperienced in this area.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; To develop and consolidate IT skills: word processing, manipulation of images, audio &amp; video, email, online safety</li> <li>&gt; To develop an understanding of how to work effectively with students and technology</li> <li>&gt; To examine how ICT is integrated into syllabus for general classes</li> <li>&gt; To develop lesson-planning and material preparation skills for internet-based resources</li> <li>&gt; To learn how to adapt and use current ICT tools with F2F learners</li> <li>&gt; To develop an understanding of blended learning and m-learning, and how these could be used in participant's own context</li> <li>&gt; To develop personal awareness of how to continue own professional development in ICT-related areas, and where and how to access this online</li> <li>&gt; To develop familiarity with search and evaluations skills for internet-based resources</li> </ul>
