Irish Culture

Infinity English College offers a course titled 'Irish Culture". Participants should be teachers of organisations offering adult or junior education and also teacher trainers, or teachers of different subjects.

Objective

This course is designed to give teachers the knowledge and materials required to incorporate Irish Culture into their lesson planning. It also enables teachers to share their ideas on how to teach students about life in an English speaking country. After this course the teachers will be able to: teach students about Irish history, writers, music and know how to incorporate this into their lesson planning, teach students about Irish folklore, customs, Irish sport and cuisine. Also the participants will learn how to incorporate culture into their lesson planning in order to give their students a better insight into real life English speaking situations, locate material on Irish culture. This is a course designed for Erasmus Plus applicants and it should be noted course accreditation does not fall under ACELS recognition. Teachers are eligible for funding for Erasmus+ funding under Key Action 1. All course participants are eligible for Europass certification on course completion.
