When can I start the course?

The majority of our courses start every Monday throughout the year.

How long can I study for?

The minimum is 2 weeks but you can study for as long as you want – up to 1 year if you wish!

What is the minimum age?

16 years old.

Is the school accredited by the British Council?

Yes, British Study Centres (BSC) is accredited by the British Council for the teaching of English as a foreign language. It is also an active member of English UK, the national association of accredited English language centres. In addition, our schools in London Hampstead, Manchester, York and Edinburgh are accredited by Eaquals.

How do I book my course?

You can easily book and pay for your course online. Alternatively, you can contact us on info@british-study.com for a list of authorised British Study Centres representatives in your country. We strongly advise you to do this as you will receive knowledgeable course advice in your own language and also information on applying for a visa (visa national students). Some agents will also book your flight tickets for you.

Do I need to pay a deposit?

Yes. We ask for a deposit of £250 to secure the course and accommodation if you require it.

Do I need a visa to study at your school?

Students from European Economic Area (EEA) and Switzerland do not need a visa to study in UK. The situation for students from other countries varies. Please check with a British Consulate or Embassy in your country of residence.

How many students are there in each class?

We have a maximum of 14 students per class and an average of 11.

Where do the other students come from?

From all over the world! We have students from Europe, South America, Asia and Africa.

Tell me about your teachers.
